# HOSPAC: Help Elect Healthcare Champions

Across the nation, healthcare issues remain at the forefront of the legislative debate.

HOSPAC, the North Carolina Healthcare Association’s political action committee, contributes to success in the advocacy arena by building relationships between community hospitals, healthcare systems, providers and their elected officials.

Those relationships ensure that hospital and healthcare system representatives are consulted before decisions are made.

HOSPAC contributes to the strongest advocates with a history in healthcare leadership. They also have a track record of championing hospitals, healthcare issues, and are supported by NCHA members.

## How HOSPAC Works

- ▶ **HOSPAC contributions are voluntary.** All salaried management staff and trustees may participate in HOSPAC as personal members. Contributions must be from personal accounts and cannot be anonymous. Contributions are not tax deductible.
- ▶ If your hospital or healthcare system has signed a HOSPAC-Federal agreement, a portion of eligible contributions will be used to support candidates for federal office.
- ▶ Trustee contributions cannot be used for federal campaigns. Trustees should indicate their position on the contribution form.
- ▶ Federal contributions can be made by full-time, salaried employees of member hospitals and health systems with managerial responsibilities and their immediate family\* (spouse, parents, children who live in the same household).
- ▶ U.S. and North Carolina laws require political action committees to collect and report the information requested on the HOSPAC donation form for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$50 in an election cycle.
- ▶ Credit card and monthly payments can be made online. Scan the QR code on the back. Checks can be mailed with this card. HOSPAC can’t accept cash donations over \$50.
- ▶ Representatives from hospitals that achieve their HOSPAC goal personally deliver HOSPAC checks.
- ▶ NCHA’s HOSPAC Committee sets annual goals and approves who receives contributions.

## HOSPAC Club Levels



### 1918 Centennial Club (\$5,000)

This club level includes membership in the American Hospital Association’s “1898 Society” with invitations to special events, priority seating at AHAPAC events, opportunities to participate in quarterly calls with political experts, access to insider political information related to elections, and recognition at all NCHA and AHA meetings.



### Champions Club (\$2,500)

This club level includes membership in the AHA Champions Club with priority seating at AHAPAC events, opportunities to participate in quarterly calls with political experts, access to insider political information related to elections, and recognition at all NCHA and AHA meetings.



### Chairman’s Circle (\$1,000)

This club level includes membership in the AHA Ben Franklin Club, invitations to participate in bi-annual calls with political experts, access to insider information, and recognition at all NCHA and AHA meetings.



### Capitol Club (\$500)

This club level receives access to insider information and recognition at all NCHA and AHA meetings.



### PAC Member (\$350)

This club level receives access to insider information and recognition at all NCHA and AHA meetings.
